Waterborne infection - Hepatitis B, Leptospirosis, Tetanus, Algal infection, stomach infection etc.	М	Н	 Pond/river areas not used during times of blue-green algal bloom. Participants instructed not to eat or put anything in to their mouths for the duration of the activity and to wash hands immediately after the session. Existing cuts or abrasions covered by a waterproof dressing and disposable gloves where appropriate. Participants developing flu-like symptoms following the pond-dipping session are advised to consult a doctor. 	L	Н

Illness or injury from plants/berries or contact with soil, fungi or animal faeces	М	М	 Pond dipping stations kept clear of prickly and/or poisonous plants. Group instructed not to eat or put any found items into their mouths, and not to touch fungi or animal faeces. Existing cuts or abrasions should be covered by a dressing. All participants instructed to clean hands thoroughly after the activity. 	L	М
