Terms and Conditions for Photo Sharing on the Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership Website



Help us celebrate the Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership by sharing your favourite photos in and around the PHLP area. These may be photos of people, the landscape, wildlife etc. When taking photos we advise everyone to follow the countryside code, keep dogs on leads when walking through the countryside and not trespass into privately owned land. Photos will be displayed on our online Visitor Photo Gallery, website and may be displayed on our social media platforms.

- 1. Electronic images only will be accepted with a maximum file size of 2mb.
- 2. Name and contact information is kept only for the purpose of us contacting you about using the photo in ways other than specified above or queries about the photo description. By entering your photographs you agree to the Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership collecting, saving and processing your personal data for this purpose.
- 3. If you would like your name included alongside your image in Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership social media and publications, you need to give specific consent for this when you upload your images.
- 4. It is your responsibility to remove the metadata embedded within the image if you do not wish to share this with us. We will store your images in the same format that they are uploaded to the website, including any metadata embedded within the image.
- 6. All entries must be the **original work** of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission to use or feature any people, content or other material, or must have the legal consent of the parents/guardians of any children under 18 who are featured. People should be made aware that their images may appear on our website, in a video reel and in printed and other media. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.
- 7. Entrants will retain copyright of the photographs that they submit to the Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership. By submitting your photographs all entrants grant the Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership the right to publish and exhibit their photographs on websites, print and other media related to the promotion of the Pendle Hill Landscape Partnership. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses. While we make ever effort to credit photographers (if consented to do so), including in printed reproductions of their work, we cannot guarantee that every broadcast use of the photographs will include the photographer's name.
